Guidelines for Recycling Fats, Oil and Grease

- Edible products ONLY (cooking oil - grease)
- Allow oil to cool before pouring into container
- All containers MUST HAVE A SEALED LID!
(use those provided or bring your own from home)
- No GLASS containers
- No fuel or motor oil will be accepted
